The Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner (OIPC) is an independent office of the legislature responsible for investigating complaints where an organization is alleged to have handled personal information in a manner contrary to the *Personal Information Protection Act* (PIPA).

We received your complaint on July 10, 2026, regarding the 127 Society for Housing. We understand your complaint is that the organization is collecting personal information contrary to PIPA.

Sections 49 and 50 of PIPA provide the Information and Privacy Commissioner with the discretion to determine whether or not to attempt to settle a matter under review.

The OIPC makes every reasonable effort to investigate alleged contraventions of PIPA. However, we may decline to investigate under certain circumstances.

The Commissioner has delegated the authority to me to decide whether or not your complaint should proceed to an investigator or be declined.

As per [OIPC Policy, Procedures and Criteria for Declining to Investigate](#), I have determined that your complaint should not proceed to investigation because the organization provided a fair and reasonable response and there is no evidence that the organization has not complied with PIPA and the review raises no other arguable issues.

I have closed your file and will take no further action.
